LAMB is a well-run major mission **Hospital, Community Health Development, Training and Research** organization. Services cover more than 6.3 million people in North West Bangladesh. The hospital is of 150 bed capacity, with fully equipped wards, labour room and operating theatres, plus a broad range of investigation facilities including X-ray, USG and ECG. The Hospital has departments of Obstetrics, Paediatrics, Internal medicine, Surgery, Nursing and a Rehabilitation Centre for Children with Disability.

Position: Senior Medical Officer/Registrar of Consultant- Paediatrics/Neonatology

Job Summary: Work within a senior team caring for in-patients and out-patients according to our guidelines, general paediatrics as well as neonatology including Labour Room support. On-call coverage together with a junior doctor. Being responsible for quality care, implementing and updating our comprehensive guidelines, teaching, and supervising junior doctors and paramedics. At LAMB, doctors also have the opportunity:

- To participate in clinical audit projects and research
- To teach in LAMB Training Centre and Nursing Institute, including HBB-courses

Essential Requirements: M.B.B.S, Internship complete and registered with BMDC; good written and verbal communication in English. At least 3 years experience in pediatrics and neonatology. PGT training in pediatrics (e.g. Diploma in Child Health) and/or any additional training or qualifications will be added benefit. Part 1 is preferred but not mandatory. Interest in further development in Paediatrics and level II Neonatology.

Age: Minimum 30-40 years.

Salary: depending on degree and experience Tk.51,000-100,000 per month; other benefits include Medical Care at LAMB Hospital, Provident Fund, and a Festival allowance once per year.

LAMB accommodation within LAMB campus is usually available for doctors with acceptable rent. Housing has security, 24 hours electricity and safe water supply. There is an on-site English-medium school for staff children.

Job Location: Parbatipur, Dinajpur.

As well as a pleasant working environment, LAMB offers a good and high standard, practical experience; working with experienced doctors having MRCP or equivalent qualifications, including expatriates.
